Mark Andrew Feister of Cadillac passed away Friday, June 23, 2017. He was 36. Mark was born on September 10, 1980 in Southfield, Michigan to Michael L & Cathy Ann (Clark) Feister.

Mark attended St. Ann School and graduated from Cadillac High School in 1999 . He attended Northwest Michigan College and Baker College. In 2008 Mark joined the Cadillac Fire Department and currently was a Lieutenant with the Department and served as the Cadillac Fire Fighters Local 704 President. Mark was a member of St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac and was a former member of the St. Stephens Parish Council.

Mark had a great off the cuff sense of humor and was a loving son, amazing brother and super devoted Dad. He enjoyed hunting trips to the Upper Peninsula, fishing trips to Canada, playing guitar, riding his Harley and was a retired member of the Rough Riders Motorcycle Club.
