Milton L. Oliver of Cadillac passed away Saturday morning, October 15, 2016 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital surrounded by his family. He was 91. Milton was born on February 12, 1925 in Harrietta to Herbert & Velno (Porter) Oliver.

Milton has lived all his life in the Cadillac area and attended school in Harrietta. He served in the United States Army during World War II.
