Myrna C. Griep of LeRoy went to her heavenly home Thursday morning, August 28, 2025 at Green Acres Retirement living in Cadillac. She was 83. Myrna was born on November 4, 1941 in Cadillac to Victor L. & L. Jean (Westman) Noreen.

In 1959, she graduated from LeRoy High School and would later receive her Bachelor's degree from Central Michigan University. Myrna had been a School Teacher for 33 years in the Pine River School District. Over the years she hosted 5 exchange students from the following countries: Switzerland, Brazil, France, Germany and Sweden. She taught 4H sewing in the Tustin/LeRoy area for many years. Myrna was a member of Augustana Lutheran Church and was the director of the bell choir for many years. She also was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church in LeRoy.

On September 22, 1984 in LeRoy she married Howard T. Griep and he preceded her in death on May 9, 1994.

Survivors include children: Alan (Brenda) Goldammer of LeRoy, Carol Card of Sheridan, Bradley (Roxanne) Goldammer of Kingsley and Howard (Diane) Griep of Cadillac; 11 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren; and her sister, Shirley Hojnacki of LeRoy. in 2024.
