Nancy Ann Ice of Cadillac passed away Tuesday, September 17, 2013 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. She was 76. She was born March 22, 1937 in Kalamazoo, Michigan to Edward and Clara (Rexer) Kalkmann.
