Pamela Jean Bennetts of Wellston, passed away suddenly Sunday, January 20, 2019. She was 65.

Pam was born February 23, 1953 in Muskegon, to Robert P. and Shirley Jane (Januska) Montney and they preceded her in death.

She graduated from Mona Shores High School and later earned her Associates of Arts Degree at West Shore Community College in Scottville. Over the years Pam worked selling Home Interiors, Tupperware and as a clerk at a gift shop in Manistee. Her greatest career accomplishment was owning and operating an in-home day care, Pine Creek Daycare that evolved into a preschool for many years.

Pam was a loving wife and mother. She was a devoted and faithful servant of God and was always comfortable sharing his love. She had the ability to lead those who did not know God, and could strengthen the relationship others already had with him. Pam was the matriarch of her family and was always willing to take on any task that needed to be accomplished before it was even asked of her. She was a constant family cheerleader; when times were tough she prayed, and when times were good she gave praise. She was known for her honest and straight forward advice, and could fill a room with her love.
