Patricia A. Flint McMahon of Cadillac passed away Monday, November 9, 2015 at Munson Medical Center in Traverse City. She was 80.

Patricia was born July 14, 1935 in Mesick to Helmer and Etta (Jenson) Loney and they preceded her in death. She graduated from Mesick High School.
