Paul A. Warner of Homosassa, Florida, formerly of the Cadillac area passed away Tuesday morning, March 20, 2012 at Hospice of Citrus County at Citrus Memorial Hospital in Inverness, Florida. He was 82. He was born on April 16, 1929 in Lake Odessa, Michigan to William and Anna (Rees) Warner. He married the former Alice Vogeding and she preceded him in death.

Mr. Warner had served in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict. He had been employed as a park ranger and special assistant to the director of conservation of the State of Michigan for 26 years until retiring on June 2, 1984.
