Randy James Tomsa of Tustin passed away on May 29, 2023, at home surrounded by family. He was 68.

Randy was born May 27, 1955, in South Haven, MI. He was the baby of the family and is survived by his siblings Earlene (Eugene) Skinner, Pamela (Charles) Berndt and Kenneth Tomsa. He is preceded in his death by his parents Earl and Eleanor (Shugars) and sister Sharon Bloodworth. He graduated from L.C. Mohr high school in 1973, where he was notably known as "The Toe". For the next 20 years, Randy worked his way up from Janitor to Plant Manager of Scott Aviation. After that, he moved on to Avon Protection as an expert in the field of filters and respirators.
