



## Reverend Keith F. Hubbard

April 18, 1923 - September 15, 2012

Reverend Keith F. Hubbard of Bay City formerly of Cadillac went to be with his Lord, September 15, 2012 at his home. He was 89. He was born on April 18, 1923 in Howard City to Franklin Gilbert & Alma Beatrice (Ketner) Hubbard.

He served in the United States Army during World War II and later graduated from Marion College in 1951. Reverend Hubbard served as Pastor at churches in Marion (Pisgah Height), Cedar Springs, Ferry, Cadillac, Bay City, and Dice from 1951 -1986. He also enjoyed carpentry work.

On December 31, 1946 in Grant, Michigan he married the former Clyda F. Wilson and she survives him along with son, Gregory (Ronna) Hubbard of Lake Topaz, NV and daughter, Nancy (Tom) Kocsis of Bay City; 4 grandchildren: Alisa (Jason) DeShano, Michelle (Pat) Hall, Dani (Dustin) Grate and Brent (Audrey) Slobe; 10 great grandchildren; 4 brothers: Lawrence (Ilene) Hubbard, Leon (Jean) Hubbard, Kenneth (Naye) Hubbard and Roger (Marie) Hubbard; 3 sisters: Marie Brown, Elaine (Chester) Ring and Virginia David Evans; sister-in-law, Ruth Hubbard; many nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a sister, Ruth Hubbard, a son, Jonathan Hubbard in 1991, a brother, Howard Hubbard. And on September 17, 2012 his daughter, Donna Hubbard died in Chicago.
