Rex C. VanNatter of Cadillac died Tuesday evening, January 17, 2012 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. He was 80. He was born in Cadillac on January 16, 1932 to Ivan & Cleo B. (Nelson) VanNatter and they preceded him in death.
