Richard Donald Johnson, of Stuart, Florida, formerly of Cadillac, Michigan, passed away Thursday, April 12, 2018. He was 88.

Richard was born November 5, 1929, in Ann Arbor, Michigan, to the late Hollis and Mary Cecelia Johnson.

Richard attended St. Thomas Academy and College in Minnesota and served in the Army during the Korean War.
