Richard L. Loughmiller of Cadillac passed away Sunday morning, October 20, 2013 at The Lakeview in Cadillac. He was 76. He was born September 1, 1937 in Shelby, Michigan to Horace and Eula Helen (Poe) Loughmiller and they preceded him in death.
