



## Robert W. Barrett

Robert W. Barrett of Harrison, formerly of Cadillac, passed away Monday, December 9, 2024 at The Brook of Gladwin. He was 95. Mr. Barrett was born November 3, 1929 in Flint, Michigan to James and Doris (McLaughlin) Barrett. On May 2, 1952 in Flint he married Joyce I. Cromwell and she preceded him in death on October 20, 2022.

Robert served honorably in the United States Army during the Korean War. After over 36 years of service Mr. Barrett retired from General Motors as a Journeymen electrician. In 1998 Mr. Barrett moved from Flushing, Michigan up North to Cadillac, where they had a cabin since the 1940's.
