Robert Allen "Bob" Fackler, of Cadillac passed away peacefully Thursday, February 12, 2016 in Grand Rapids, Michigan. He was 73 years old. Bob was born April 27, 1942 in Lorain, Ohio to Harry and Rita (Warren) Fackler.

Loving husband of Ann (Reincke), they were married July 10th, 1984. Bob was preceded by his parents, his half-sister, Marilyn (Fackler) Younkman; brother in-law, Carey Younkman and half brother, Harry Fackler Jr.

Bob is survived by his wife and her son, Robert Reincke; nephew, Craig (Marie) Younkman; niece, Jerri (Roger) Oliver and niece, Nancy Wright.

Bob taught Economics and Mathematics at L'Anse Creuse High School and High School-North from 1966 to 1994, where he was admired by students for his teaching style, encouraging students to excel in sports, academics and investing in their future. As a young man Bob played baseball, later took up golf, wrote and performed music, and enjoyed the outdoors. Bob was an avid and successful investor and speculator. Bob began to spend time in Michigan's upper-peninsula in the 1960s. Later in life, over a number of years, Bob hand-built a beautiful summer home on the shores of Lake Superior where he enjoyed spending his summers relishing in the peace and solitude. Bob was an avid lover of all animals but particularly cherished his German

Sheppard Snow-White, and his West-Highland White Terriers, Teddy and Boschee.
