Robert F. Logan of Tustin passed away Tuesday morning, January 6, 2015 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. He was 85.

He was born on February 16, 1929 in Grand Rapids to John Edward & Merea (Smith) Logan and they preceded him in death. Bob has lived in this area for over 70 years.

Mr. Logan had served in the United States Air Force from 1946 to 1949. He had been employed at Kysor in Cadillac for 22 years and retired in 1991. He was a member of Temple Hill Baptist Church in Cadillac and the Pine River Historical Society. Mr. Logan loved to collect old tractors, read Westerns, hunting and having coffee and conversations with friends and family. Bob served on the Burdell Township board of review for many years and was also the caretaker of the Burdell Township Cemetery for 25 years.

On December 3, 1949 at the Dover Baptist Church he married the former Verona L. Gribbell and she survives him along with their 5 sons: Mike (Debbie) Logan of Tustin, William (Julie) Logan of Tustin, Ken (Donna) Logan of Cadillac, Steve Logan of Tustin and Ron Logan of Downingtown, PA; 7 grandchildren: Tracy (Corey) Logan-Walker, Lisa Logan, Chris (Ashley) Logan, Aprille (Garett) Kruse, Matthew (Jennifer) Logan, Jessica (Mark) Savoie and Adam Fullerton; 10 great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by 4 brothers and a sister.

Funeral services will be held 11:00AM Friday, January 9, 2015 at Temple Hill Baptist Church in Cadillac with Reverend Jack Miller officiating.
