Robert Schut of Cadillac passed away Monday, January 14, 2013 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. He was 85. He was born on October 17, 1927 in McBain to Claus & Hattie (Yonkman) Schut and they preceded him in death. On August 4, 1950 Bob married the former Dorothy Nystrom and she preceded him in death on June 1, 1975.
