Robert G. Stanhope of Lake City passed away Monday morning, July 2, 2018 at Munson Medical Center in Traverse City. He was 67.

Bob was born September 9, 1950 in Jacksonville, Arkansas to Warren Max and Dorothy (Shepherd) Stanhope and they preceded him in death.

He graduated from Corunna High School in 1968 and moved to Lake City from Owosso in 1969. Bob graduated from Kirtland Community College while working for Cadillac Rubber and Plastics. From there he started his own business, Advanced Rubber Technologies in Cadillac. He was a member of Rehoboth Reformed Church in Lucas. He was passionate about basketball, golf, water skiing and old cars. He was a Ducks Unlimited Sponsor. Bob was a strong man; he was an 11 year double lung transplant survivor, and he would ask that you consider being a donor through Gift of Life Michigan so that others could have the same gift he had.
