Roger Alan Husted of Cadillac passed away Saturday evening, January 13, 2018 at his home. He was 71.

Roger was born November 6, 1946 in Cadillac to Elmer N. and Bernadean A. (Sundberg) Husted and they preceded him in passing.

He graduated from Cadillac High School in 1964 and went on to attend college in Indianapolis. Roger then served in the United States Air Force for four years. After his services he moved around the State of Michigan several times before settling in Cadillac to raise his family.
