Roy E. Hewett of Cadillac died Thursday morning, December 16, 2010 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. He was 79. He was born on July 27, 1931 in Cadillac to Stanley Lawson & Bessie (Davis) Hewett and they preceded him in death. He had lived all his life in the Cadillac area and graduated from Cadillac High School in 1950.
