



## Russell Hemstreet, Jr.

September 25, 1926 - August 1, 2012

Russell Hemstreet, Jr. of Harrietta passed away Wednesday August 1, 2012 at his home. He was 85. He was born September 25, 1926 in Flint, Michigan to Russell Glen and Eleanor (Yankee) Hemstreet and they preceded him in death.

Mr. Hemstreet had been employed at Consumers Power for 37 years retiring on January 1, 1990. He had lived in the Cadillac area for the past 21 years. Russell had served his country in the United States Army during World War II. He was a member of the VFW of Flushing, the Evening Optimist Club and the Independent Bible Church of Cadillac.
