Ruth Ann Stoll, 'Devoted Wife', of Boon died Saturday, June 25, 2011 at Mercy Hospital in Cadillac. She was 42. She was born in Cadillac on April 28, 1969 to Jay W. and Jane Ann (Gross) VanderBrook.
