Scott Steven Martinson of Cadillac passed away, Tuesday, December 30, 2025 at Munson Medical in Traverse City. He was 54.

Scott was born January 2, 1971 in Cadillac, Michigan and later graduated from Marion High School in 1989. Scott earned his bachelor's degree and went on to work at Spencer Plastics in Cadillac for many years.

He was an avid hunter and loved anything with a motor, especially Arctic Cat from an early age. Scott loved being Brandon's right-hand mechanic for all things snocross and motorcross and was always thinking of ways to make Brandon's machines faster and run more efficiently. Their family enjoyed many trips to Silver Lake Sand Dunes with their quads, national and regional snocross races together and made many good friends through those experiences.

On June 18, 2005 he married Heather L.
