Sergio A. Delgado of Cadillac passed away, Tuesday evening, August 12, 2025. He was 36.

Sergio was born April 1, 1989 in San Francisco, California. He attended St. Elizabeth Catholic School in Palo Alto and later graduated from Woodside High School in California. After high school Sergio attended massage school where he found love and moved to Michigan to start a family. He was blessed with his son, Simon, who he lived for.

Once in Michigan Sergio worked at MC Sports and later began his career in law enforcement/ security. He worked with the Wexford County Sherriff's Department for several years before moving to be the School Resource Officer for Mesick Schools. Sergio was currently Assistant Director of Campus Safety at Interlochen Center for the Arts.

Sergio loved the outdoors; camping, hunting and fishing were some of his favorite activities and he enjoyed sharing those with his son.
