Shirley Geraldine (Jacobson) Fauble was born to Roland & Opal (Hoel) Jacobson on March 11, 1942, on Colfax Street in Cadillac. She attended Lincoln Elementary School and graduated from Cadillac High School in 1960. While in grade school she was baptized at the Temple Hill Baptist Church. Also, while in grade school she received a silver dollar for being the quietest girl from all the grade schools at an assembly. As a teenager she worked at Cunningham's Drug Store, Dahlquist Store and Olan Mills.

On December 10, 1960, at Independent Bible Church she married Clarence (Pudge) Dean Fauble. She worked at Michigan Bell Telephone Company for 18 years as a Telephone Operator and at Medical Arts Group for 13 years also as a Telephone Operator. Since then, she had worked part time as a home health aide. When her children were in grade school, she was active in the PTA and as a room mother several times. Shirley had been a member of the Independent Bible Church since she was in grade school. She enjoyed working in her yard and at her age she was able to remember her grade school & high school friend's phone numbers.

Shirley had been a volunteer for Cystic Fibrosis for many years. Her favorite holiday was Easter; her favorite color was red and her favorite city to visit was Traverse City. She collected Snow babies, Porcelain dolls and birds and she loved to make lasagna, which everyone loved.
