Shirley Ann Winner of Cadillac passed away Friday, September 22, 2023 at Autumnwood Nursing Home in McBain. She was 94. Shirley was born June 30, 1929 in Saginaw, Michigan to George J. and Eleanor I. (Lambert) Lehr.

She graduated from Clare High School and later worked at Boyne Citizen at City Boyne for seven years. Shirley then worked at Montgomery Wards in Traverse City and Cadillac for nine years until working at Stephans's Drug Store in Cadillac for 13 years, retiring in 1992. Throughout her working career Shirley also worked in real estate in the area.

Shirley was a faithful member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Cadillac for many years. She was the Prayer Chain Coordinator for many years, served on the Lutheran Women's Missionary League, Alter Gild, choir and helped with the annual sauerkraut supper for many years.

She is survived by her children, Tyler Winner of Lake City, Ronalee (Larry) Wilson of Colorado; a niece and one grand- niece.

On July 8, 1947 in Clare, Michigan she married Paul E. Winner and he preceded her in death on September 22, 1974. She was also preceded in death by a brother, George Jay Lehr.

Memorial services will be held 11:00 AM, Thursday, October 5, 2023 at Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Cadillac with Pastor Brennan Woell officiating. Her final resting place will be Cherry Grove Cemetery in Clare, Michigan.
