Stephen Douglas Johnson of Cadillac passed away Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital. He was 78.

Steve was born March 21, 1943 in Cadillac to Walter and Constance (Trowbridge) Johnson and they preceded him in death.

He graduated from Cadillac High School in 1962. Shortly after that, he began a career in banking Cadillac State Bank, retiring 31 years later. After leaving the bank, he worked at Fiamm for 10 years.
