



## Terry H. Fox

August 4, 1943 - September 25, 2025

Terry H. Fox of Cadillac passed away Thursday, September 25, 2025 at his home. He was 82. Terry was born on August 4, 1943 in Ludington, Michigan to Harold & Marguerite (Hoover) Fox.

In 1961 he graduated from Ludington High School. Terry had been employed with Giant Supermarkets for 30 years retiring in 1997. After his retirement he went to work at Bryan Vending and retired in 2006 from there.

Terry was an avid outdoorsman. For years he enjoyed bird hunting with his Labrador retrievers and had not missed an opening day of trout season in 76 years. He also enjoyed traveling and spending his winters in Gulf Shores, Alabama. Terry enjoyed going out for breakfast with his friends weekly. More than anything, his pride and joy were his grandchildren, he never missed their sporting events through the years. And if you knew Terry you would agree that he was a great story teller.

On July 10, 1965 in Ludington he married the former Glenda L. Bentz and she survives him along with their daughter, LeAnne Bush (Art Szewczyk) of Cadillac; grandchildren: Gregory Bush and Olivia Bush both of Cadillac; 2 sisters-in-law: Gwen Baxmeyer and Glenette (Jerry) Keson; his niece, Laura (Ignacio) Medelez; his nephew, Adam Baxmeyer and Terry's special friend, Mike (Diane) Everson. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a brother, Robert Fox.
