Theresa Ann Knight of Cadillac passed away Saturday, December 9, 2016 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital. She was 93.

She was born on September 28, 1923 in Grand Rapids, Michigan to John & Catherine (Sweeney) Atkins. On December 5, 1944 in New York, NY she married Alan James Knight and he preceded her in death on July 11, 2000.

Theresa graduated from Union High School in Grand Rapids and had served in the United States Navy during World War II. She has lived in the Cadillac area for the past 30 years and was a member of St. Ann Catholic Church in Cadillac. Mrs. Knight was known as the "Mitten Lady" in Cadillac and over the years has made and donated hundreds of mittens to various schools and charities all while remaining anonymous. Her family was her priority and she loved to garden and cook.
