Timothy Martin Haines of Cadillac passed away peacefully December 21, 2023 at Munson Healthcare Cadillac Hospital surrounded by his wife and daughters. He was 68. Tim was born July 21, 1955 in Center Line, Michigan to Louis Milton and Marguerite Ann (Nosko) Haines.

He graduated from Cadillac High School in 1973 and later started his own construction business.
