Timothy Dennis Philo, life-long resident of Cadillac, passed away on Friday, June 3rd at age 66. He was graciously cared for in his final days by the wonderful, compassionate staff at Samaritus Senior Living in Cadillac and his children, Kerry and Dennis Philo, were by his side when he departed.

Tim and Juanita were married for 35 years. After retiring, they spent several years traveling, collecting antiques, working in their flower gardens and keeping up with their home on west 13th street. Tim also loved stock-car
