



## Timothy M. Vollmar

February 26, 1958 - May 28, 2015

Timothy M. Vollmar of Cadillac passed away Thursday, May 28, 2015 at the U of M Hospital in Ann Arbor. He was 57.

Tim was born on February 26, 1958 in Manistee, MI and shortly after moved to Cadillac where he lived all his life.

Tim went to the Flint School of the Deaf until 1975. And from 1975 to 1977 he attended the Cadillac High School where he graduated from. He then went to the Hennipin Technical College in St. Paul, Minnesota and graduated from there in 1980. Tim came back to Cadillac and later became employed at Four Winns and worked there for 30 years retiring in 2013.

Mr. Vollmar was a member of the Cadillac Elks Lodge #680 and the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Cadillac. He loved fishing, wood working, metal detecting, coin collecting, all sports, going for walks and playing tennis.
