Verona Lois Logan of Tustin passed away Wednesday morning, June 9, 2021 at home. She was 91.

Verona was born on August 13, 1929 in Graham Township, Johnson County, Iowa to Fredrick J. & Ruth S. (Jacobs) Gribbell.
