Virginia I. Anderson of Cadillac went to be with her Lord Friday, January 25, 2013 at The Lakeview in Cadillac. She was 91. She was born on January 10, 1922 in Cadillac to Pearl Leroy & Merle Irene (Mosher) Brooks and they preceded her in death.

Mrs. Anderson had been a school teacher for 3 years and later was employed at the Cadillac State Bank.
