



## Wilson Emmor "Bill" Irey

May 22, 1921 - February 26, 2015

Wilson Emmor "Bill" Irey of Cadillac, formerly of Rochester Hills, passed away Thursday, February 26, 2015 at Curry House Assisted Living. He was 93.

Bill was born May 22, 1921 in Detroit, Michigan to Carl and Lillian (Parker) Irey, and they preceded him in death.

Bill served in the United States Army during World War II. He worked for Michigan Bell Telephone Company for 42 years before retiring in 1982. Upon retirement Bill became a member of the Telephone Pioneers and for over 30 years he volunteered to repair equipment for the Talking Book Program of the Library of Michigan Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped. Bill was proud to have earned his pilot's license. He was a longtime member of the First Congregational Church of Rochester, United Church of Christ.

For many years he enjoyed regular lunches with the "Lunch Bunch." He loved gardening, had a green thumb and could grow anything. Bill was an avid woodworker and had the ability to fix anything. He was a wonderful grandfather and conversationalist who loved people and animals.

On July 8, 1944 in Detroit he married the former Jeannette "Jay" Thompson and she survives him along with their children: Jill Irey of Cadillac,
